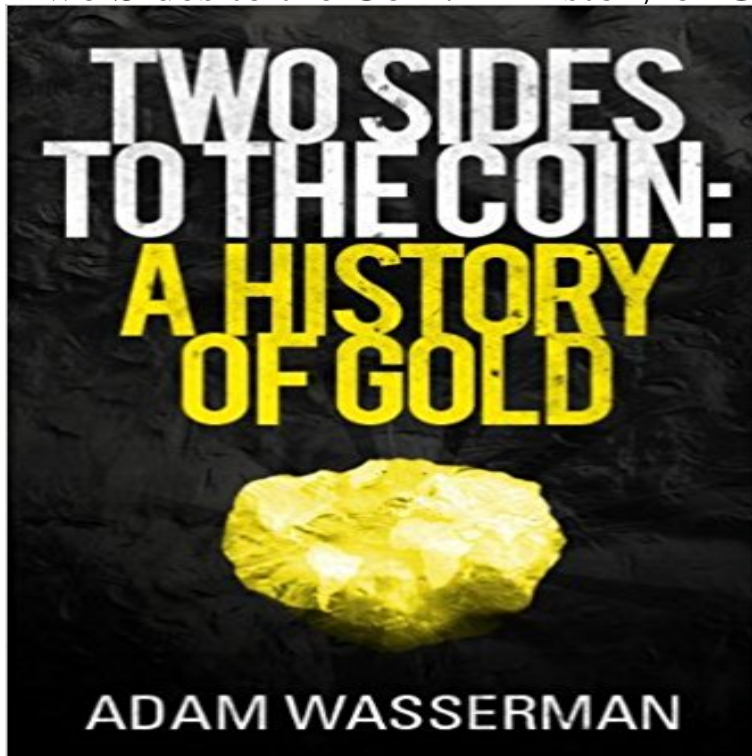


Two Sides to the Coin: A History of Gold
