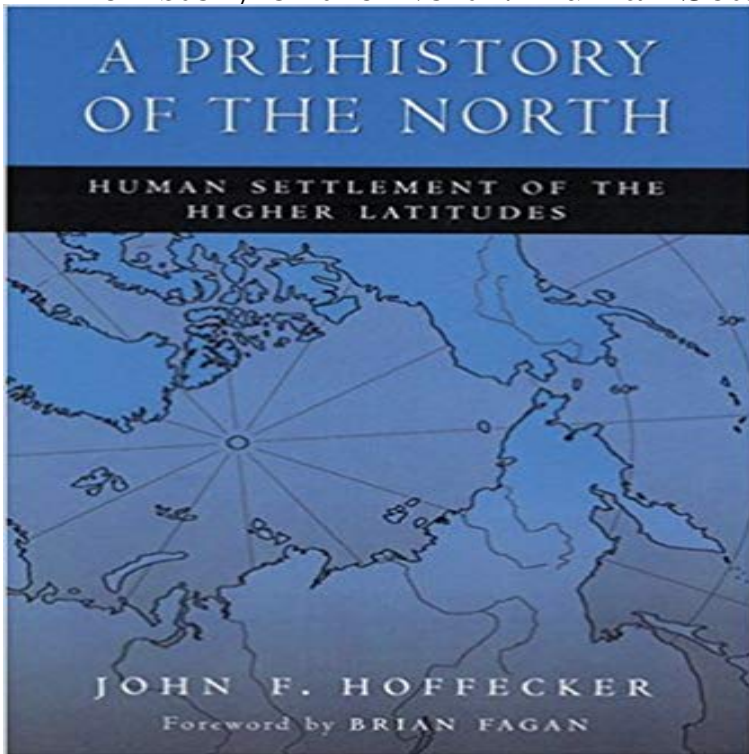


## A Prehistory of the North: Human Settlement of the Higher Latitudes
