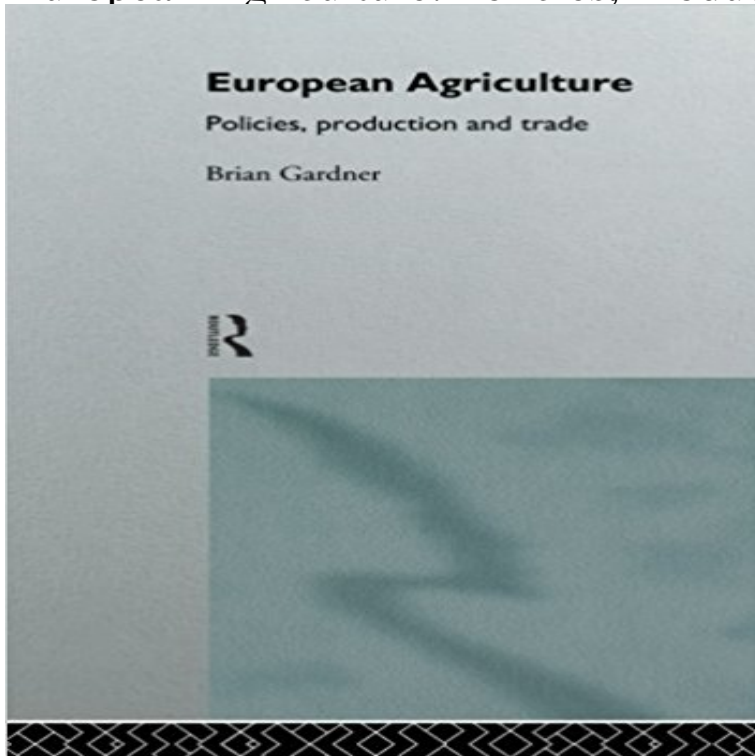


# European Agriculture: Policies, Production and Trade
