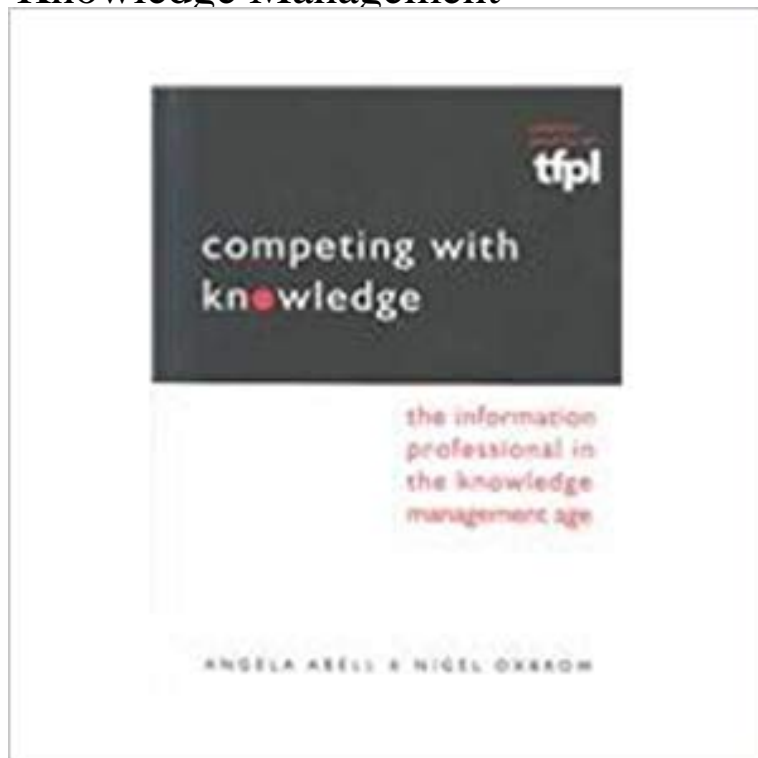


# Competing With Knowledge: The Information Professional in the Knowledge Management
