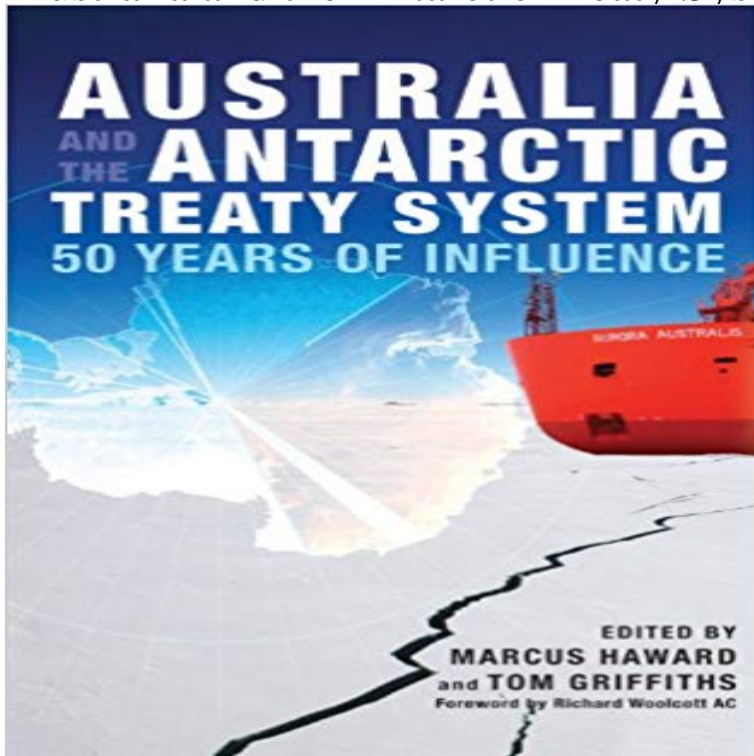


Australia and the Antarctic Treaty System: 50 Years of Influence
