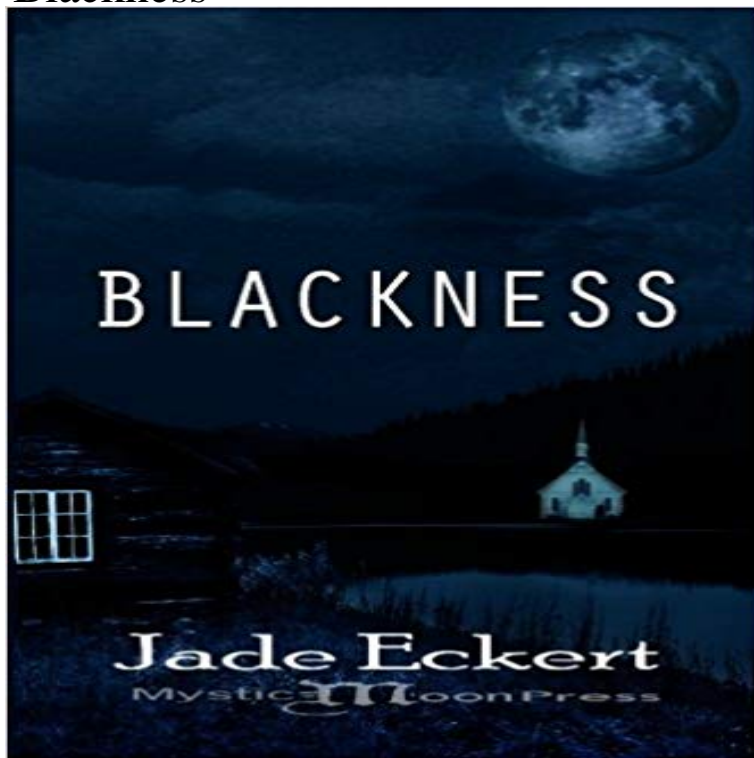


# Blackness
