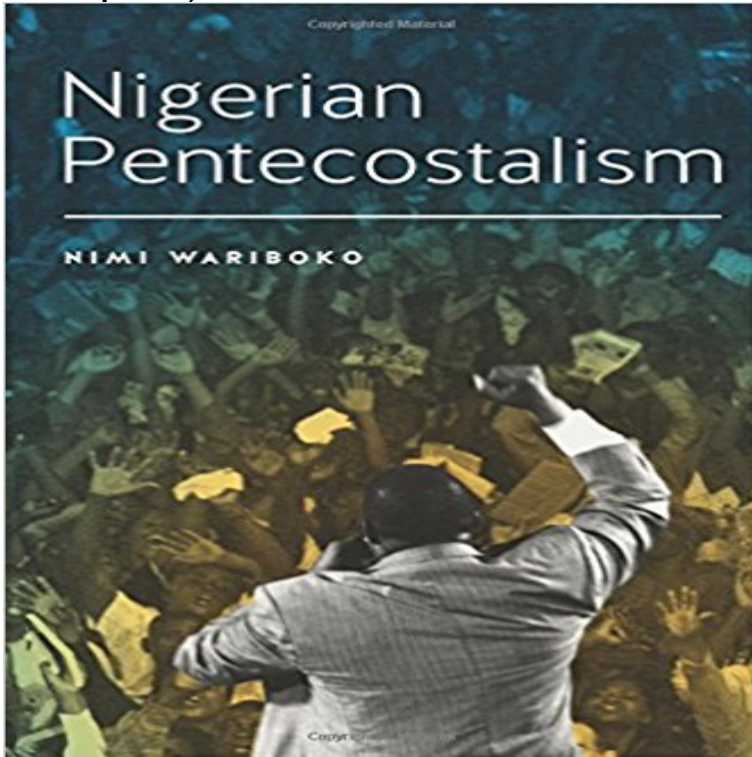


Nigerian Pentecostalism (Rochester Studies in African History and the Diaspora)
