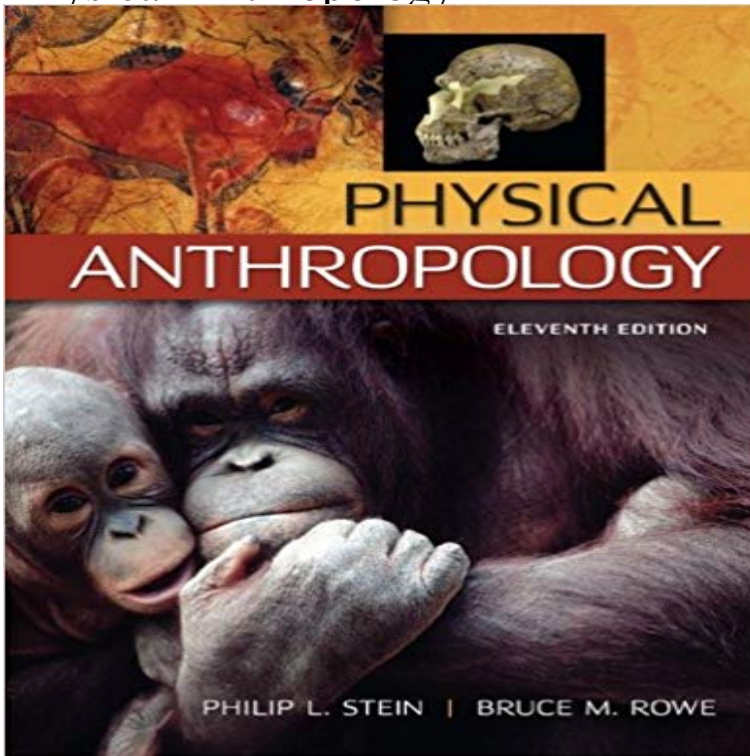


# Physical Anthropology
