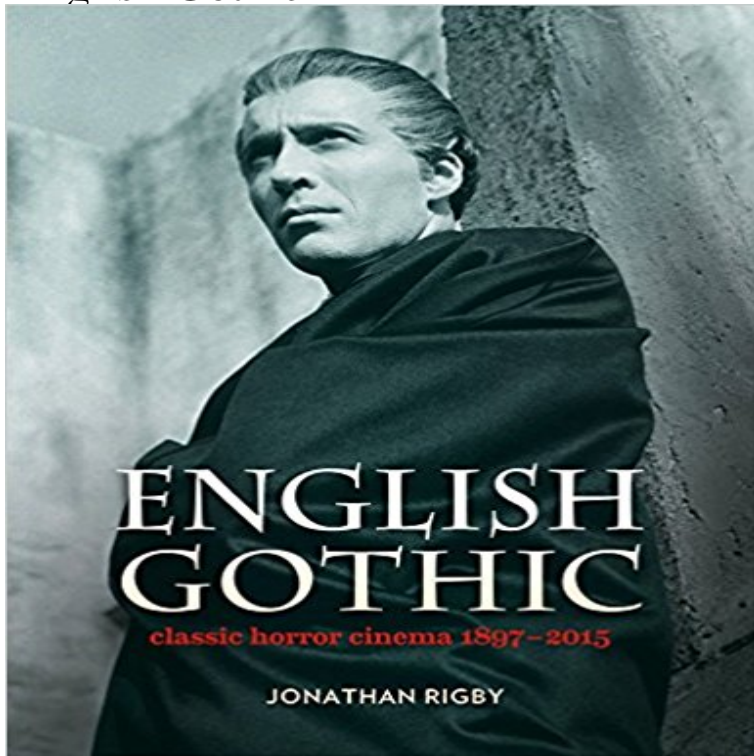


English Gothic
