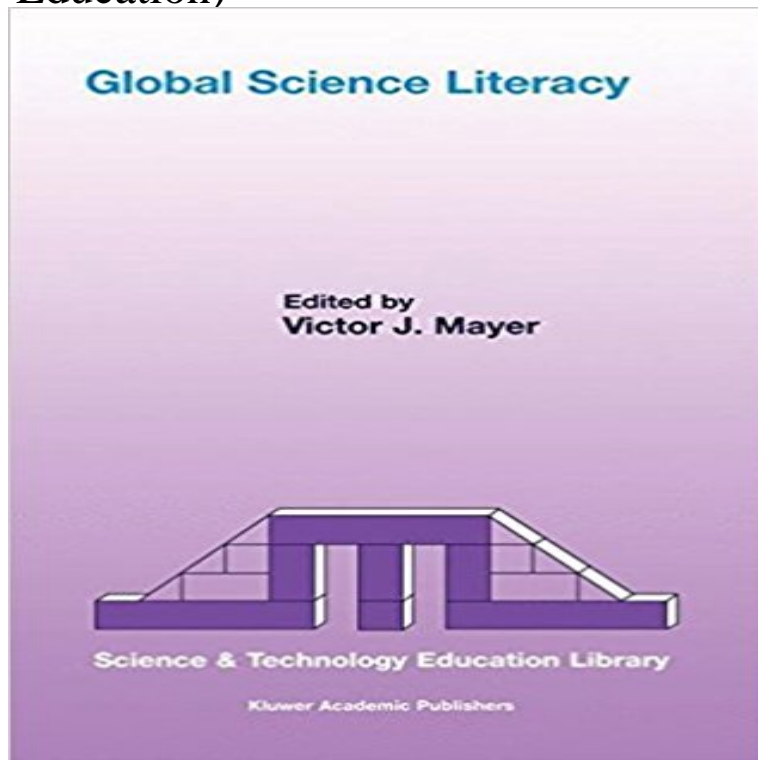


Global Science Literacy (Contemporary Trends and Issues in Science Education)
