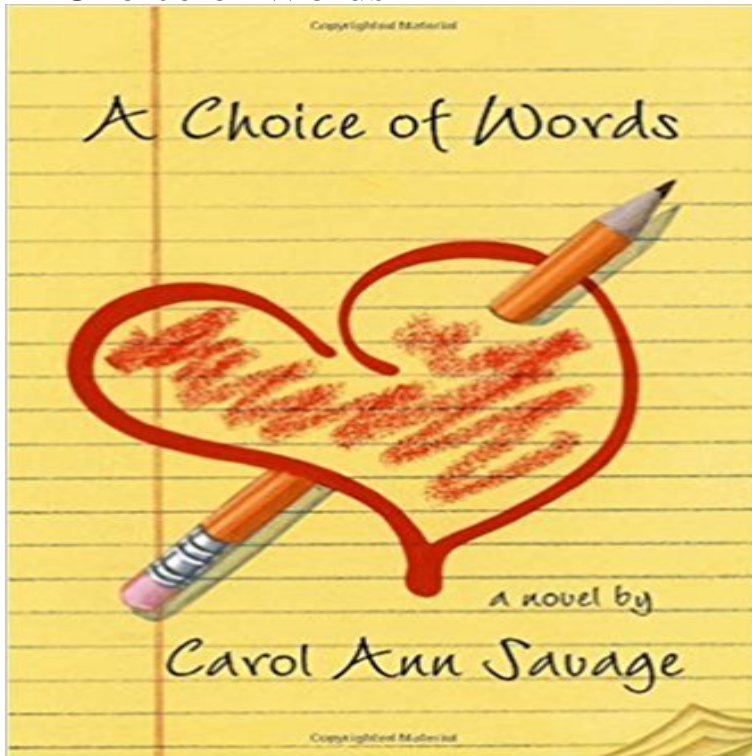


A Choice of Words
