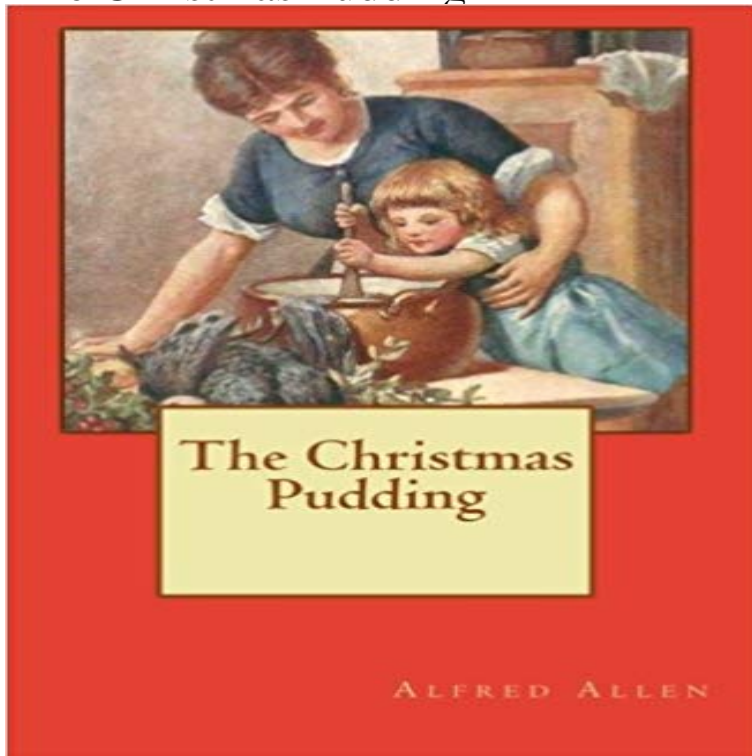


The Christmas Pudding
