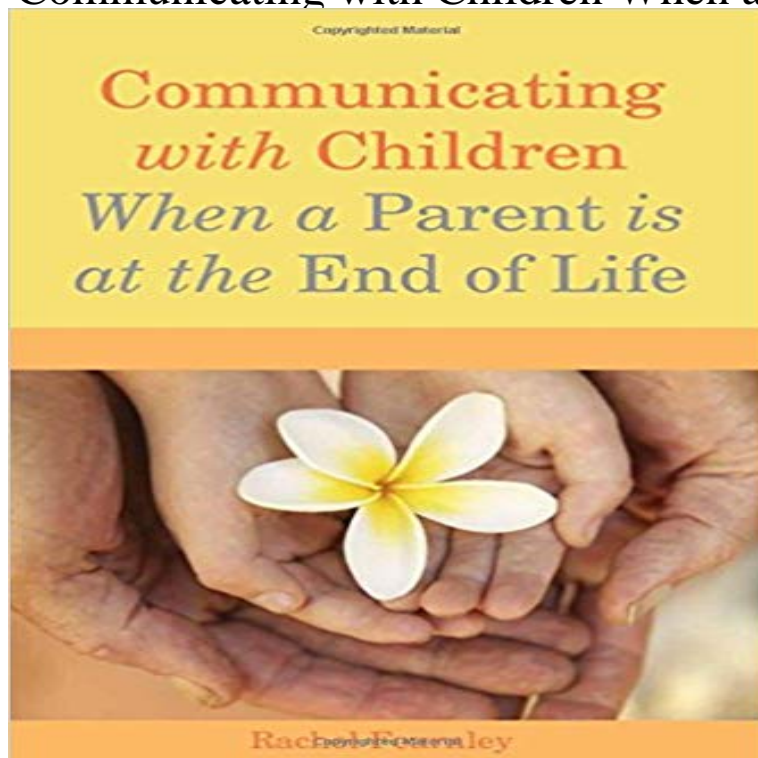


Communicating with Children When a Parent is at the End of Life
