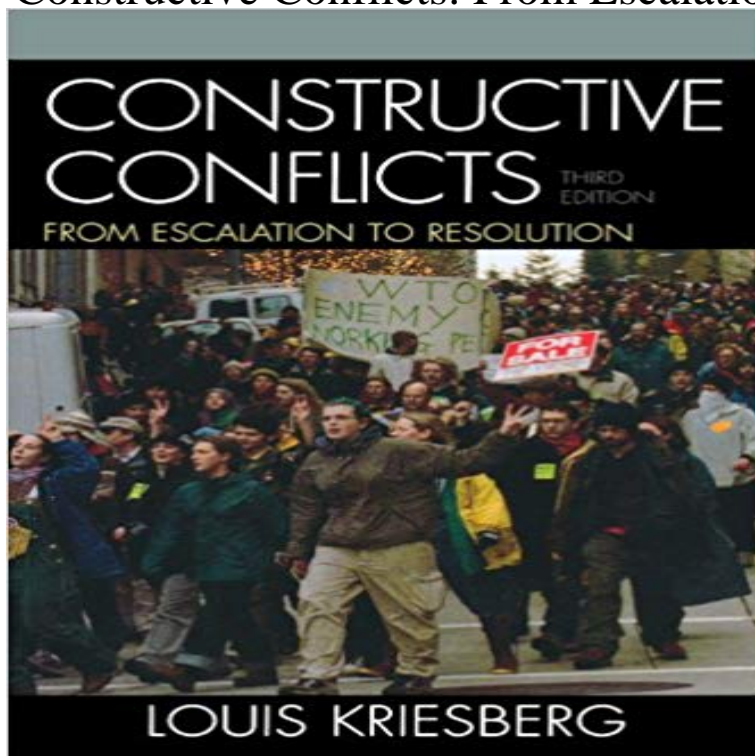


Constructive Conflicts: From Escalation to Resolution
