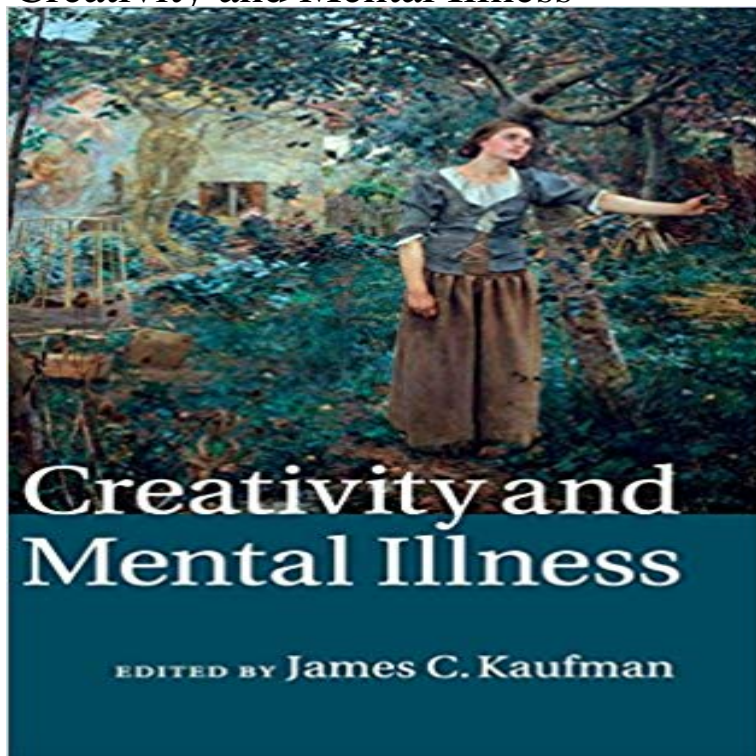


## Creativity and Mental Illness
