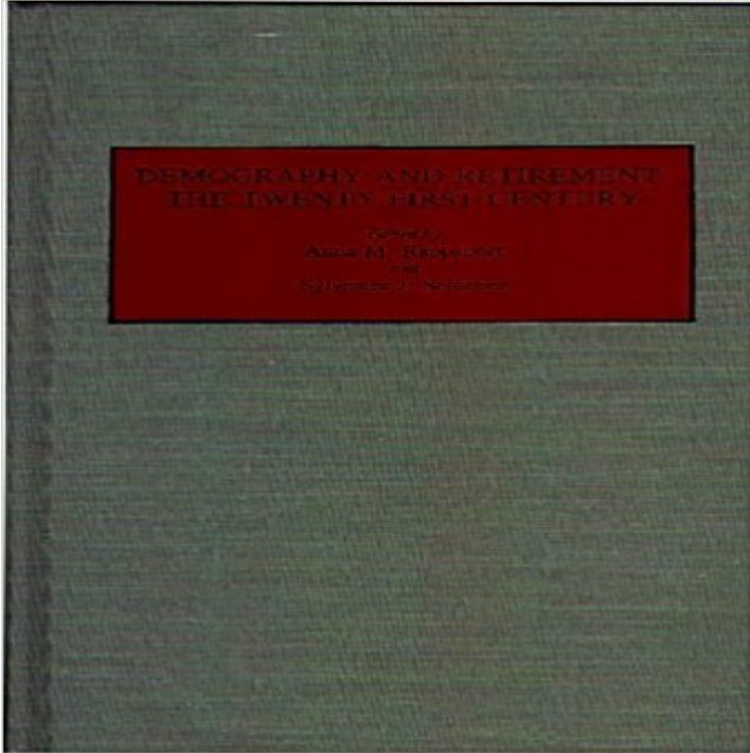


Demography and Retirement: The Twenty-First Century
