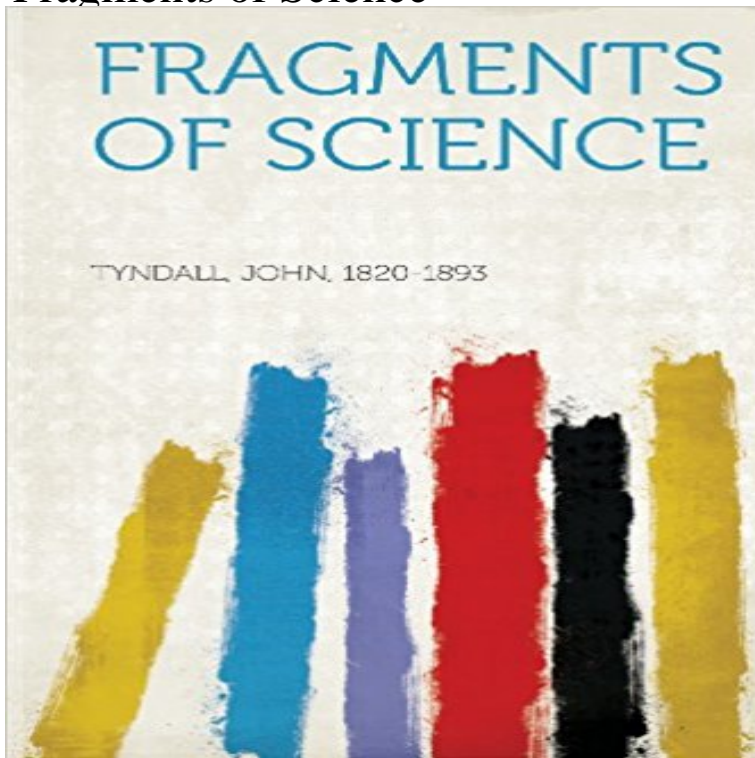


Fragments of Science
