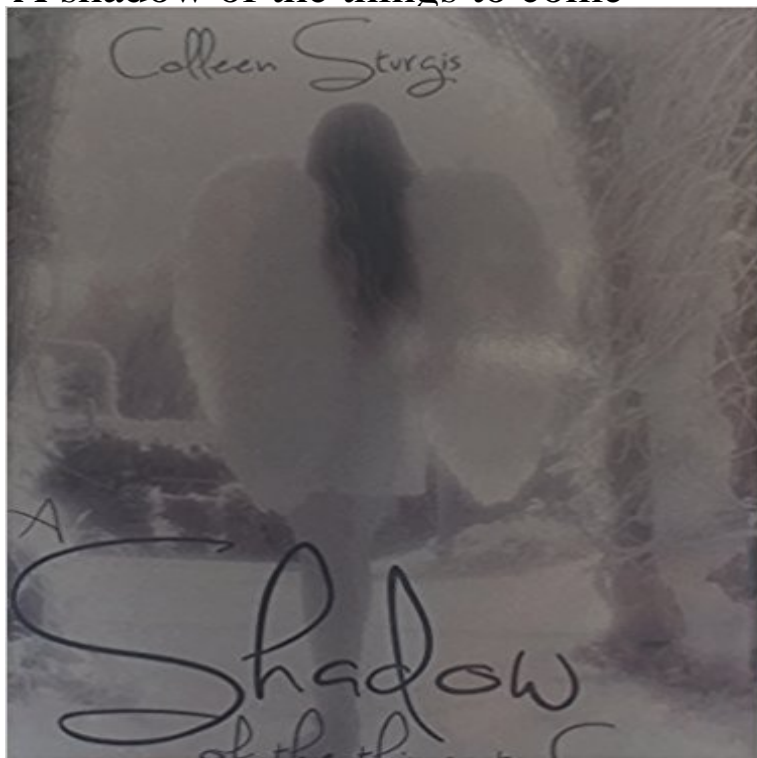


A shadow of the things to come
