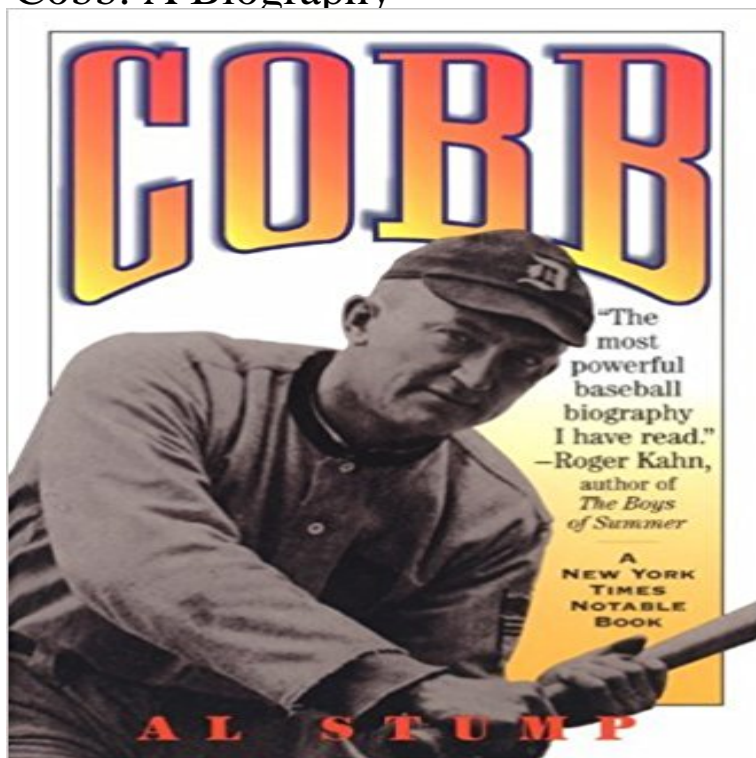


Cobb: A Biography
