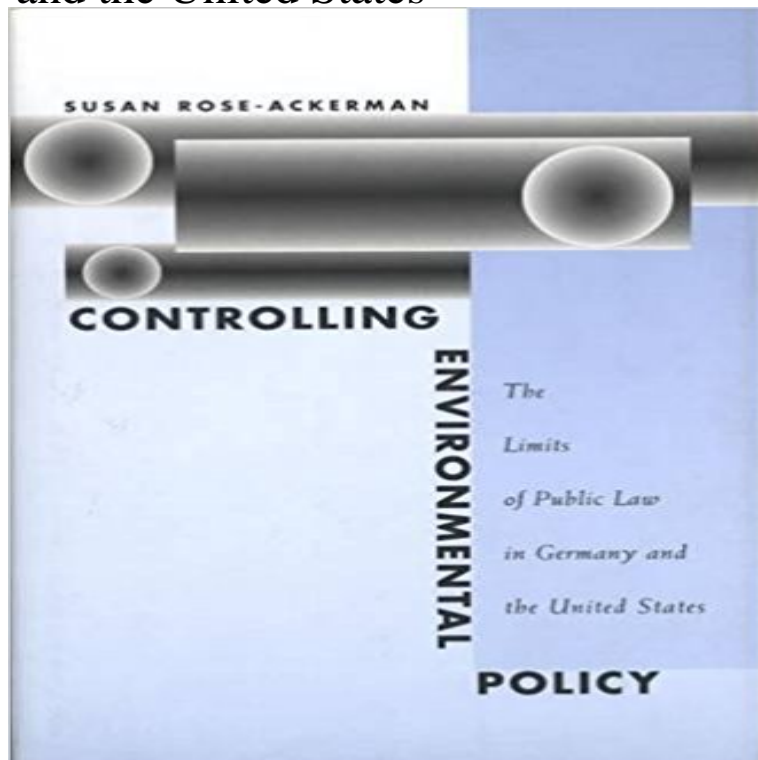


# Controlling Environmental Policy: The Limits of Public Law in Germany and the United States
