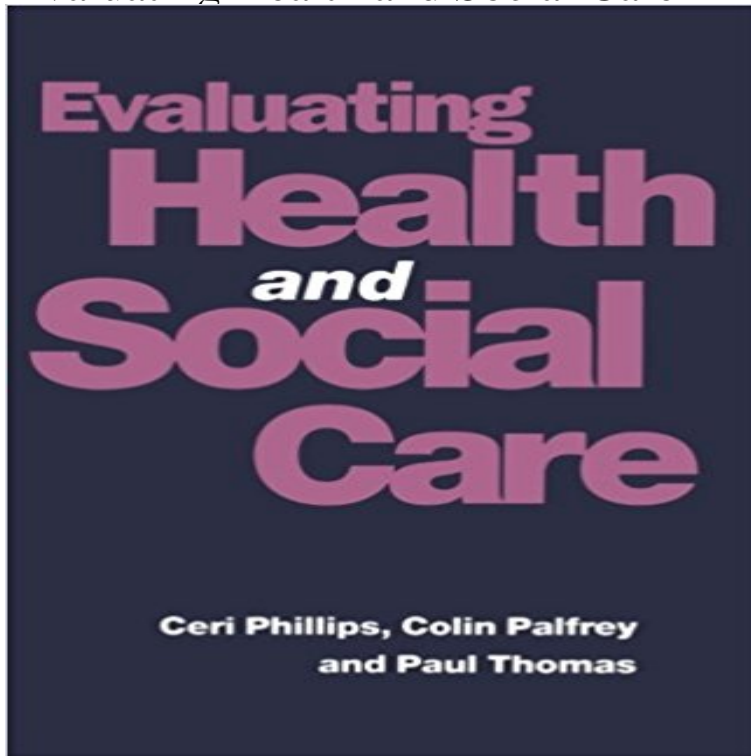


Evaluating Health and Social Care
