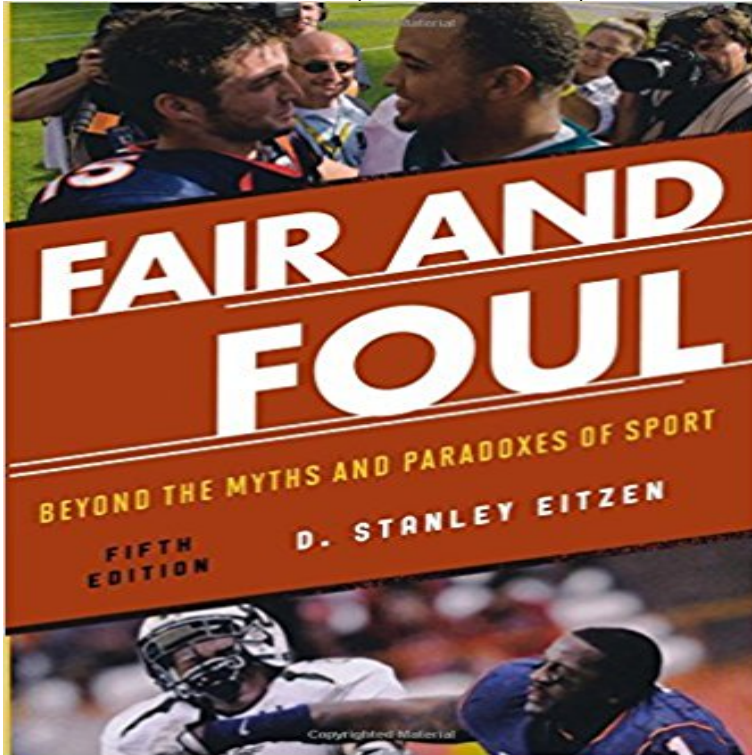


## Fair and Foul: Beyond the Myths and Paradoxes of Sport
