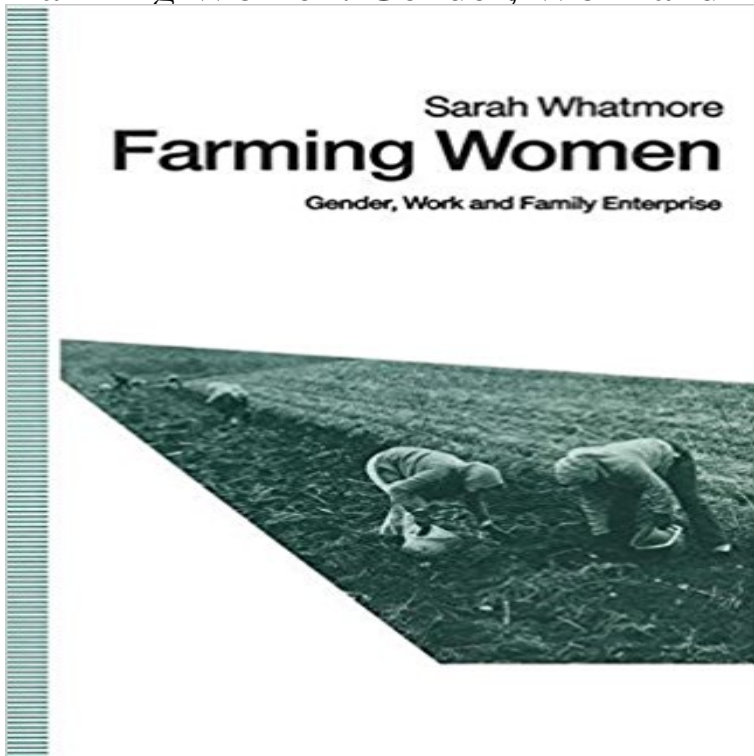


Farming Women: Gender, Work and Family Enterprise
