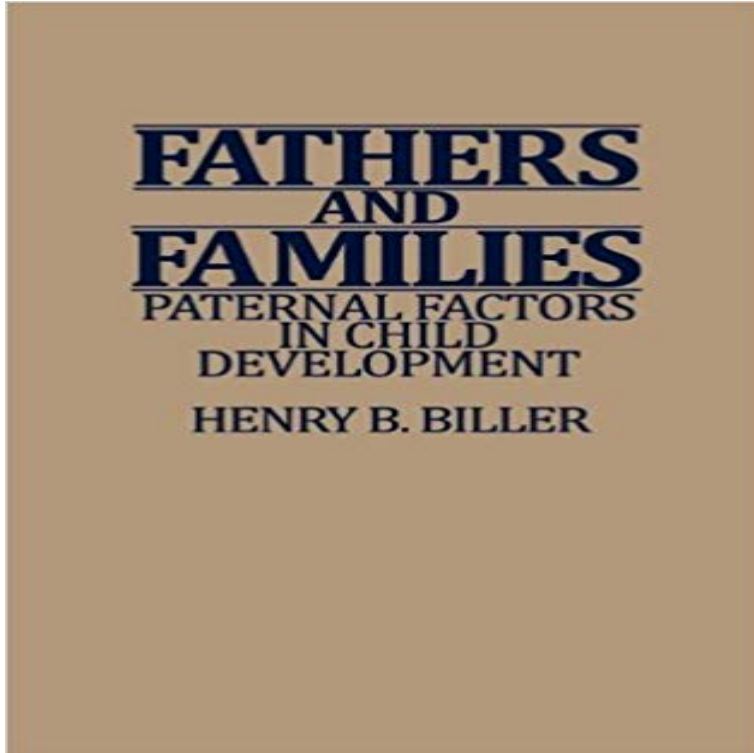


Fathers and Families: Paternal Factors in Child Development
