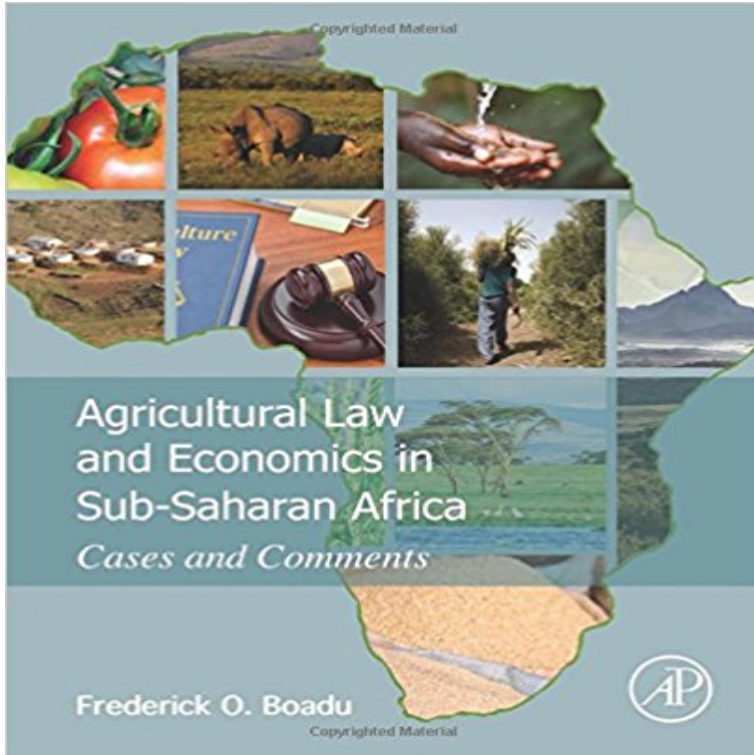


# Agricultural Law and Economics in Sub-Saharan Africa: Cases and Comments
