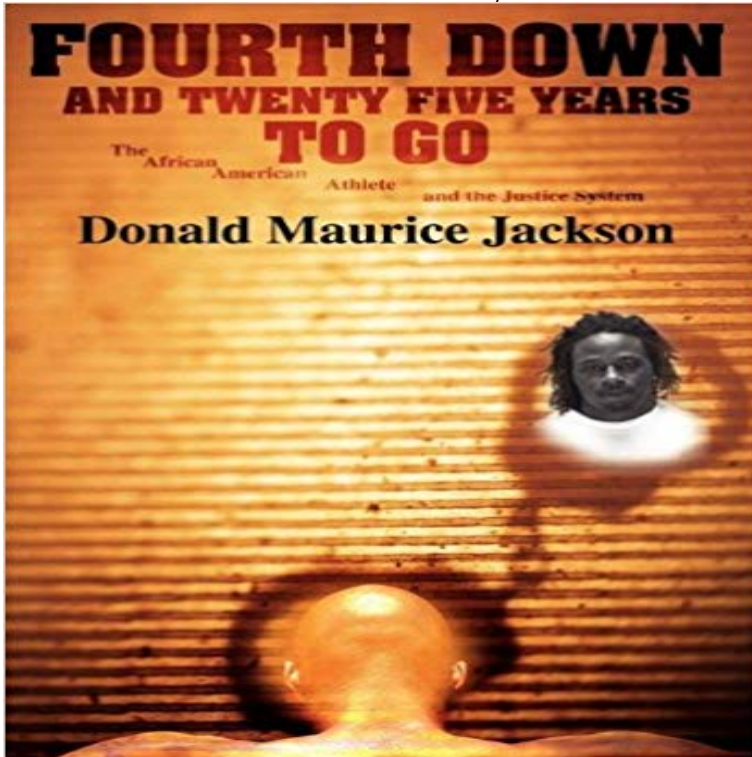


Fourth Down and Twenty Five Years To Go: The African American Athlete and the Justice System
