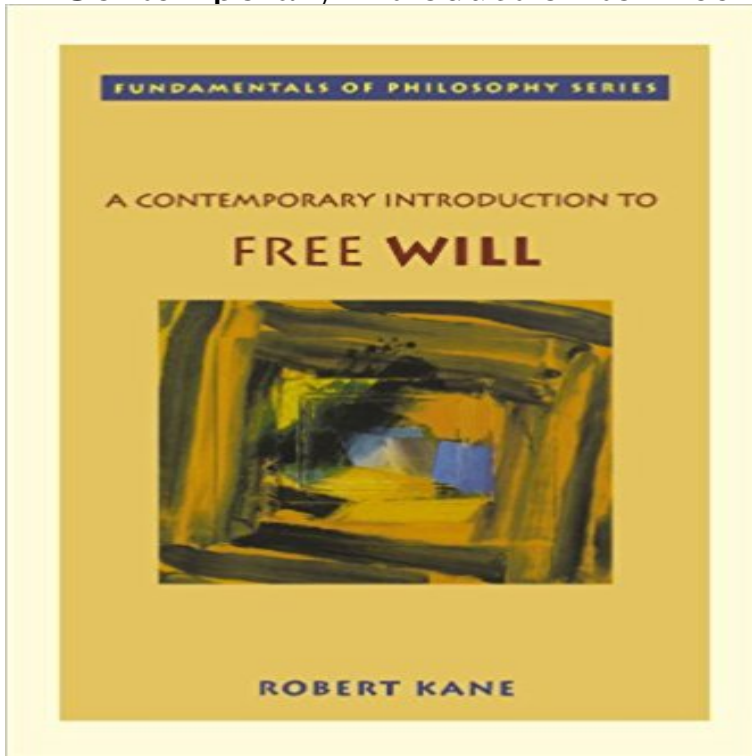


A Contemporary Introduction to Free Will
