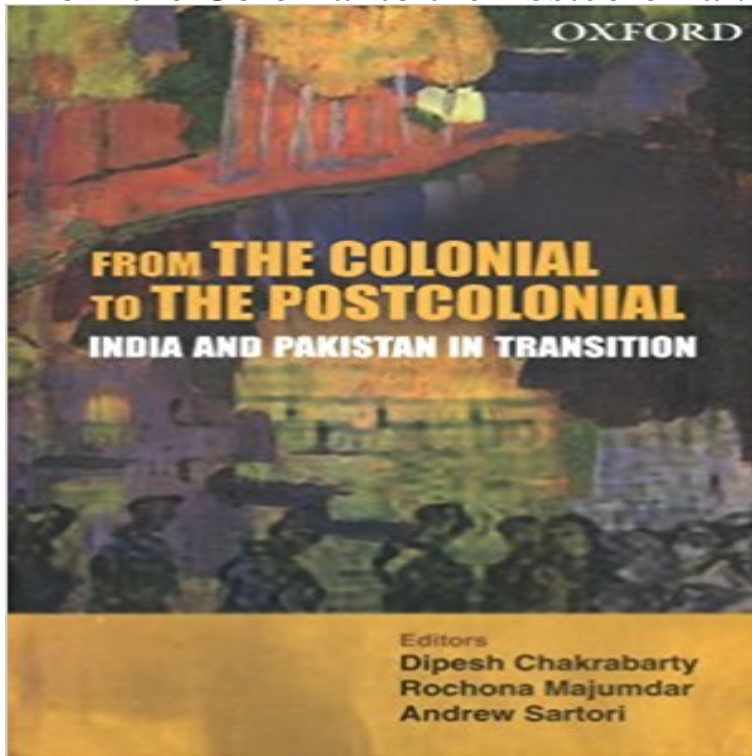


From the Colonial to the Postcolonial: India and Pakistan in Transition
