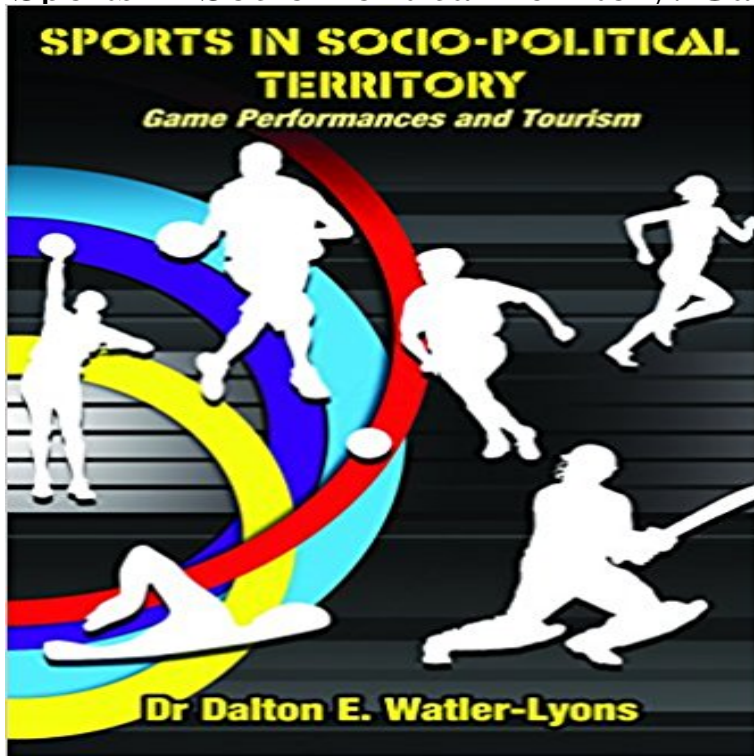


Sports In Socio-Political Territory: Game Performances And Tourism
