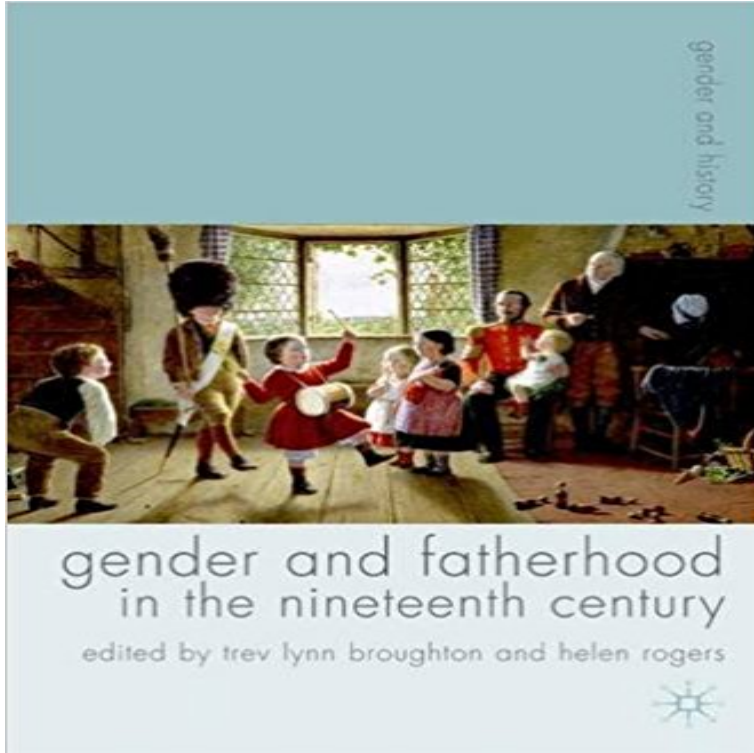


Gender and Fatherhood in the Nineteenth Century (Gender and History)

Examining how paternal power was embedded in social institutions, it argues that fatherhood invoked more anxiety and debate than hitherto acknowledged.
