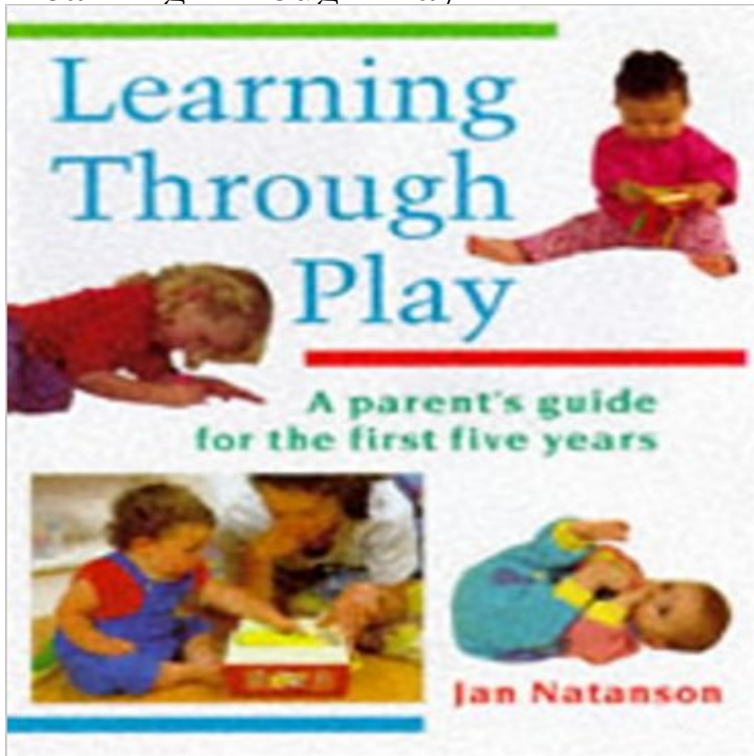


Learning Through Play
