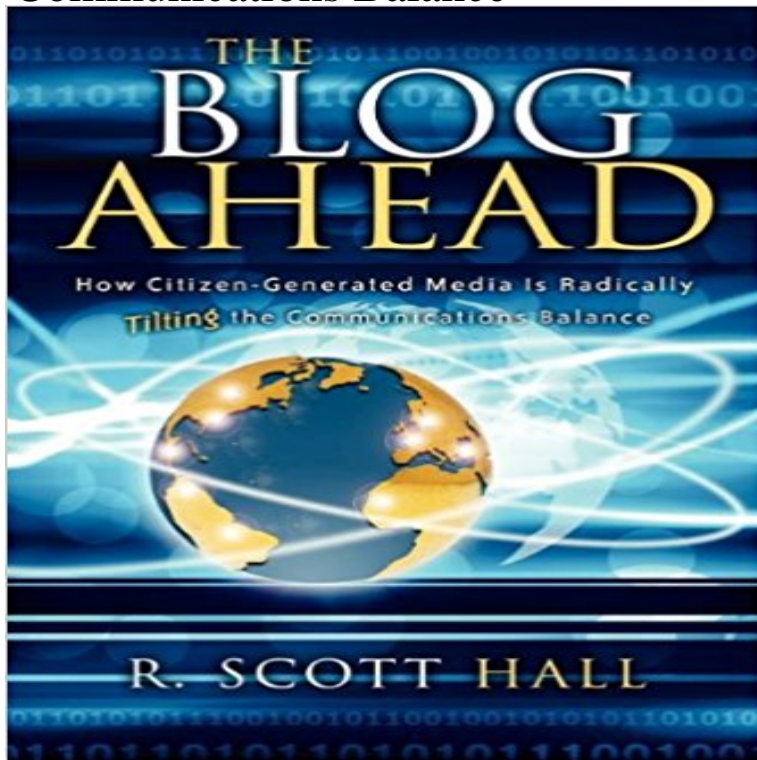


The Blog Ahead: How Citizen-Generated Media Is Radically Tilting the Communications Balance

Hall gives a trenchant, often humorous, analysis of this revolution in the human Zeitgeist, ranging from politics, to media, to the arts.
