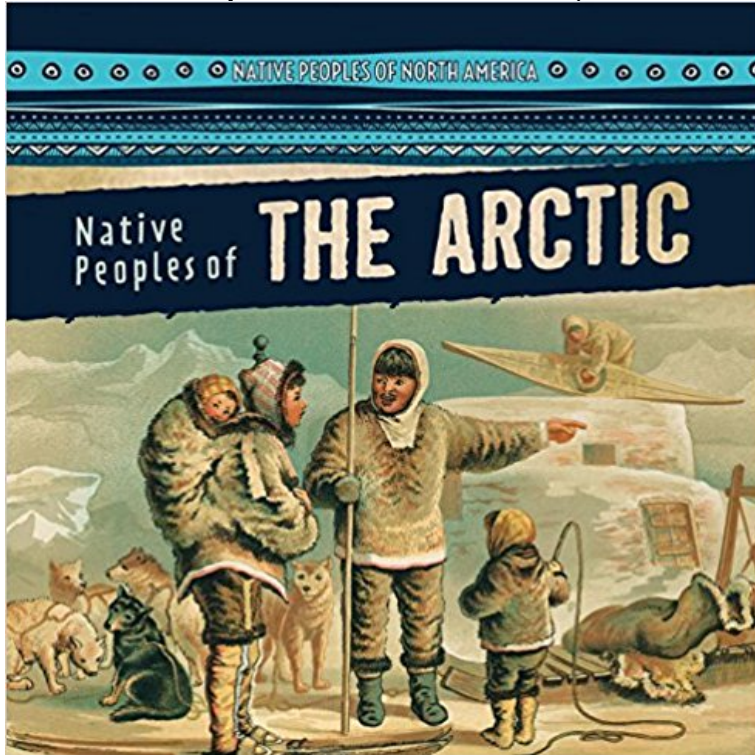


Native Peoples of the Arctic (Native Peoples of North America)
