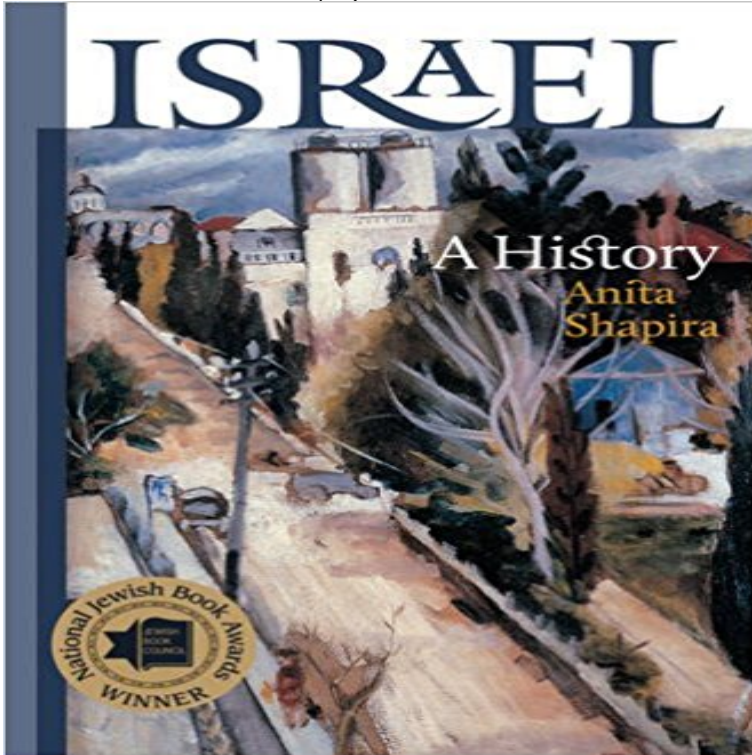


Israel: A History (The Schusterman Series in Israel Studies)
