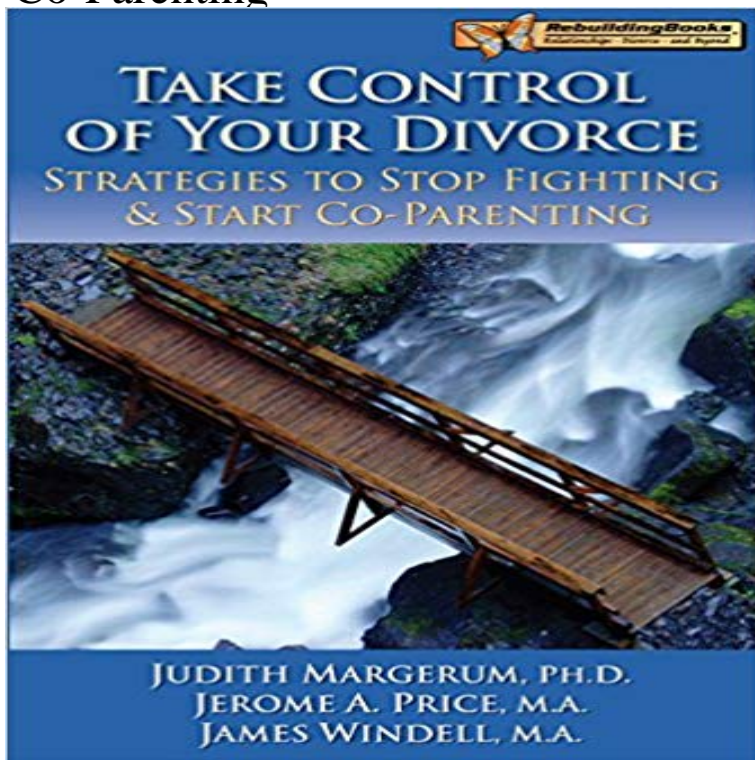


Take Control of Your Divorce: Strategies to Stop Fighting & Start Co-Parenting
