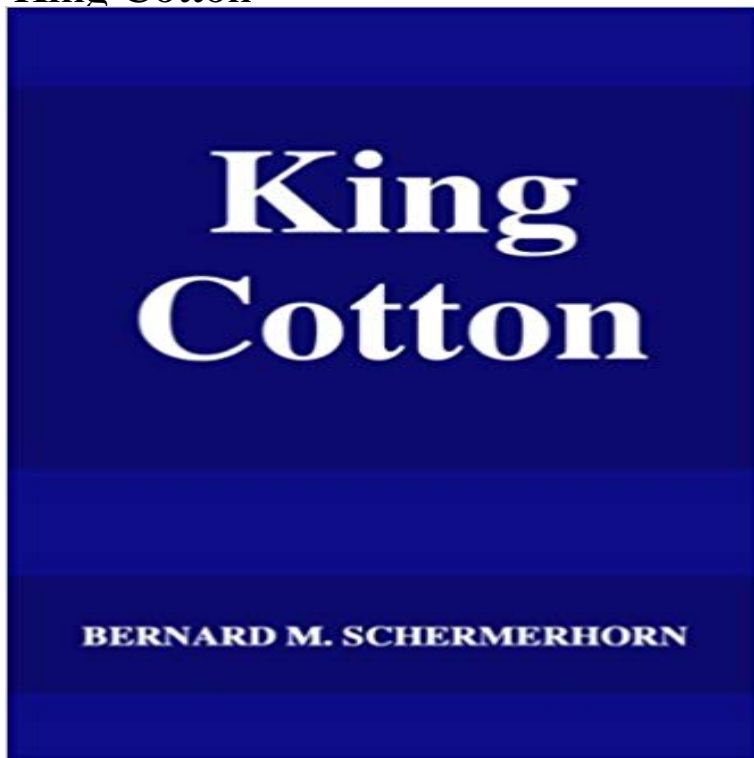


King Cotton
