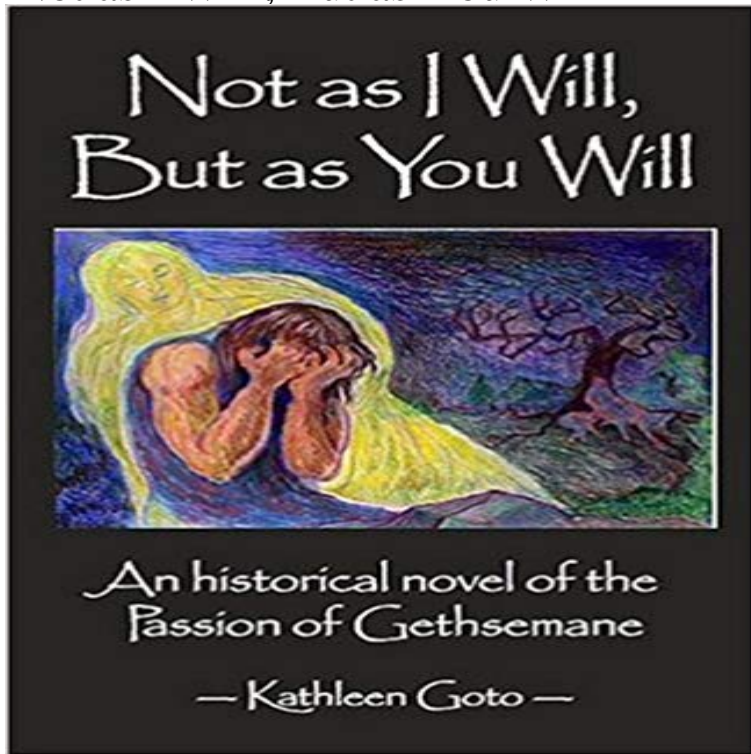


Not as I Will; But as You Will
