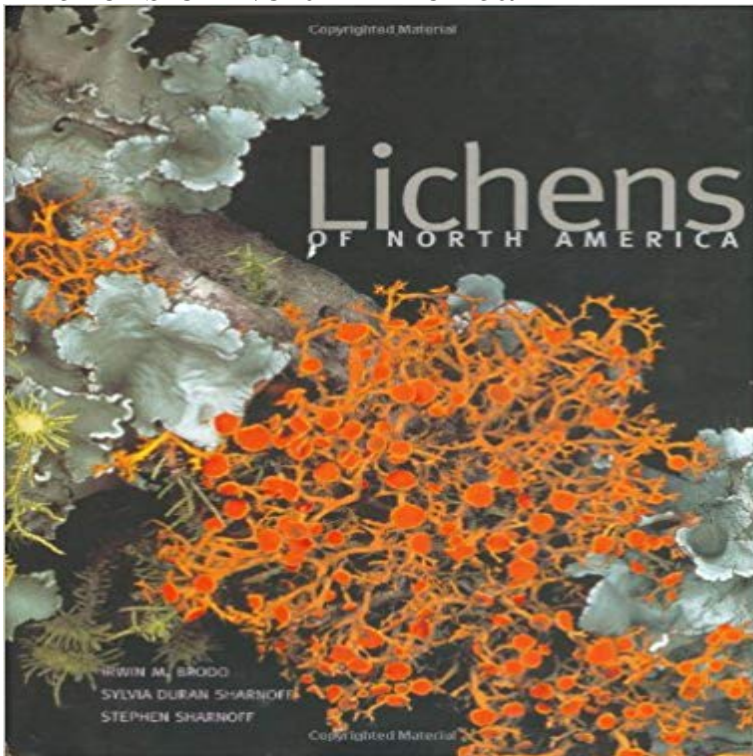


Lichens of North America

English names are provided for most species, and the book also includes a glossary that explains technical terms.
