
Stroke: A Guide for Patient and Family

These specialists discuss the adjustment problems, motor skill problems, language and speech problems, spatial-perceptual deficits, bladder and bowel problems, and sexual problems that can accompany stroke. A chapter written by an architect suggests structural modifications in the home to meet the patients needs.
