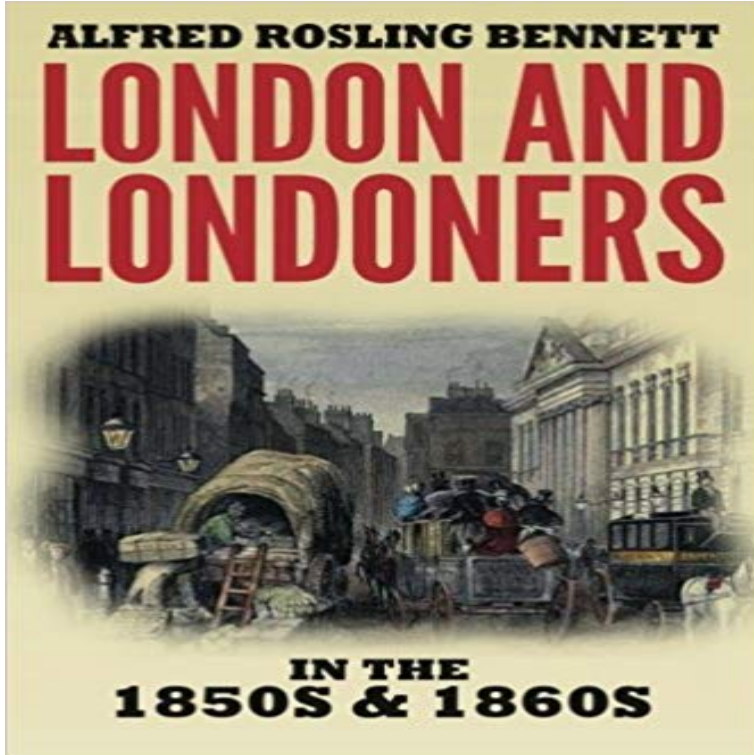


## London and Londoners in the 1850s & 1860s

Bennetts life was defined by the industrial revolution and in his life as an engineer he was part of that revolution himself. His life and his experiences were unique and his actions helped to shape modern Britain. He was the general manager and chief engineer of the Mutual Telephone Company and the New Telephone Company and fitted the first ever incandescent lights in Scotland. Author of Historic Locomotives and many other works, Alfred Rosling Bennett was a committed writer and in London and Londoners in the 1850s & 1860s, Bennett turned his quick mind back to his childhood in London.
