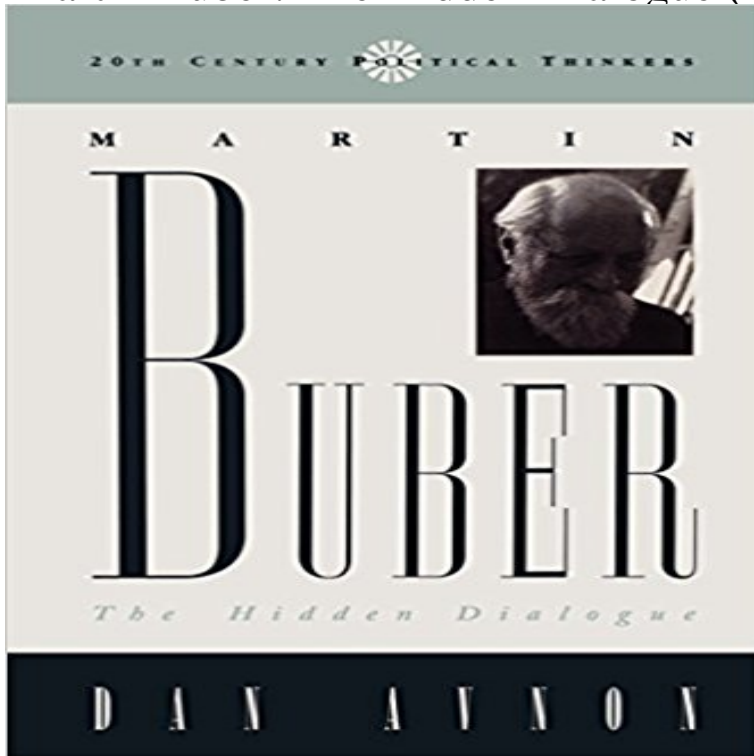


Martin Buber: The Hidden Dialogue (20th Century Political Thinkers)
