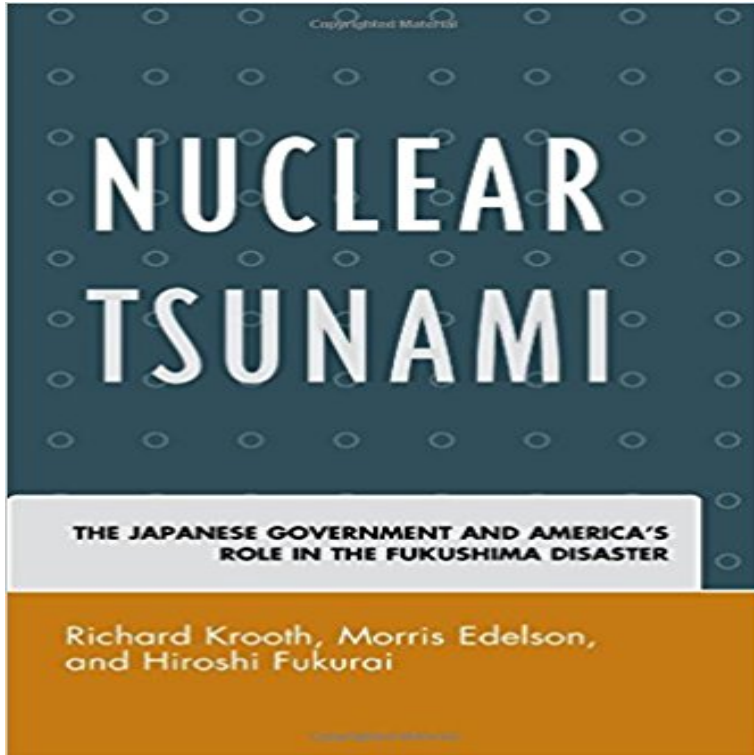


Nuclear Tsunami: The Japanese Government and Americas Role in the Fukushima Disaster
