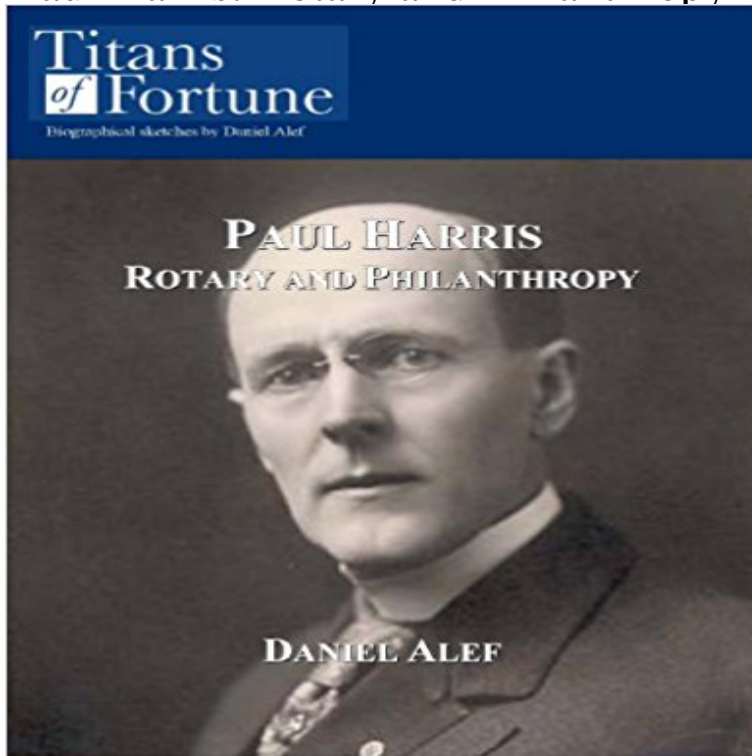


Paul Harris: Rotary and Philanthropy
