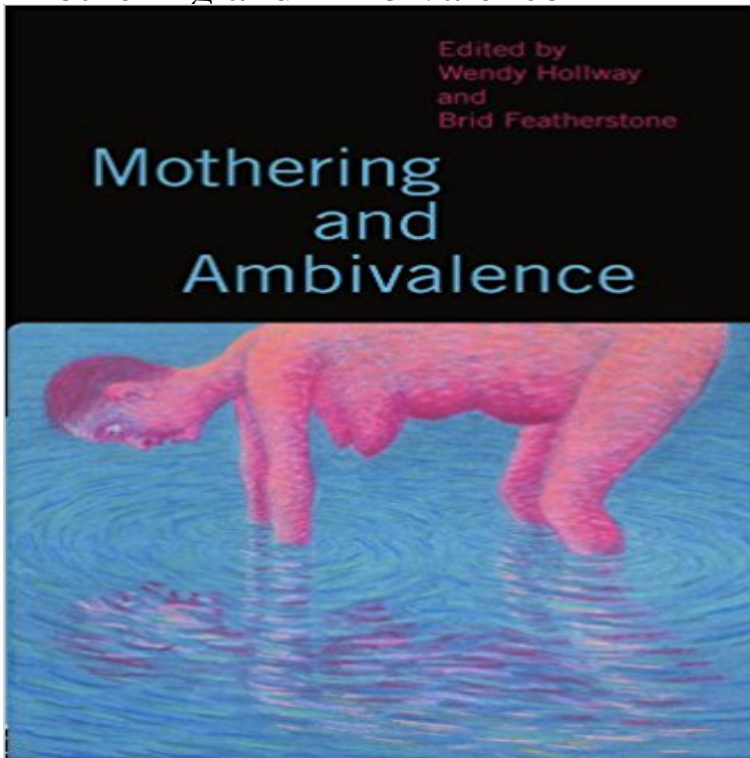


## Mothering and Ambivalence
