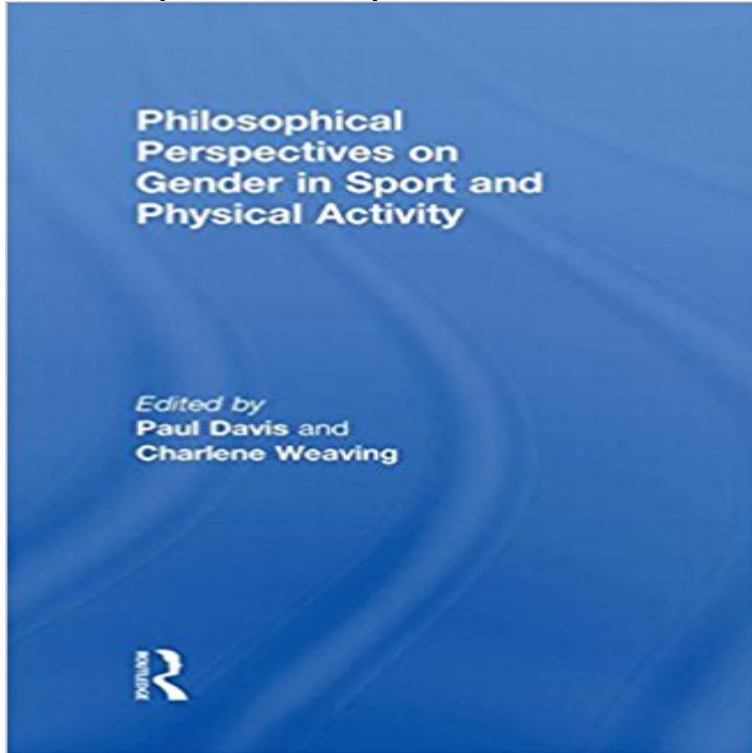


# Philosophical Perspectives on Gender in Sport and Physical Activity
