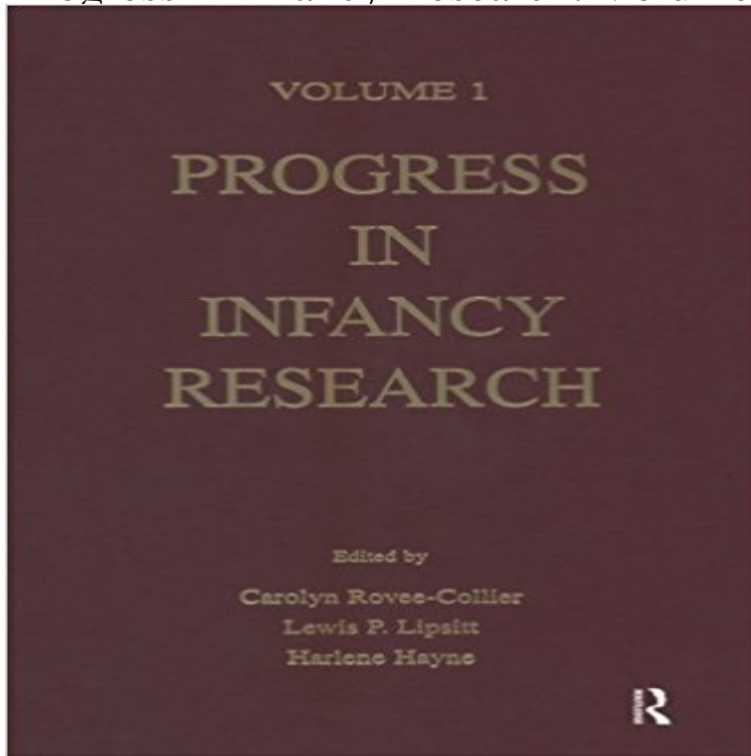


Progress in infancy Research: Volume 1
