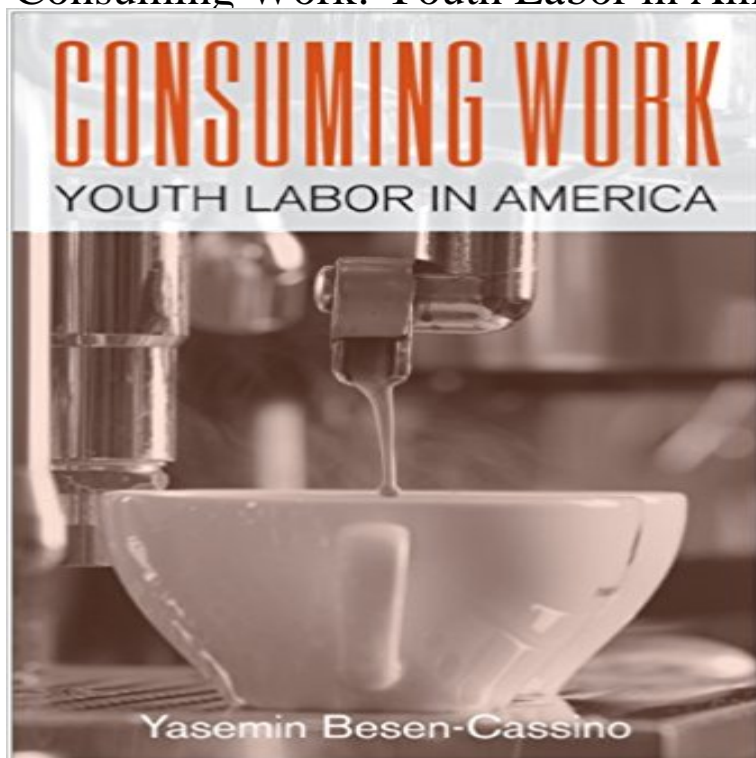


Consuming Work: Youth Labor in America
