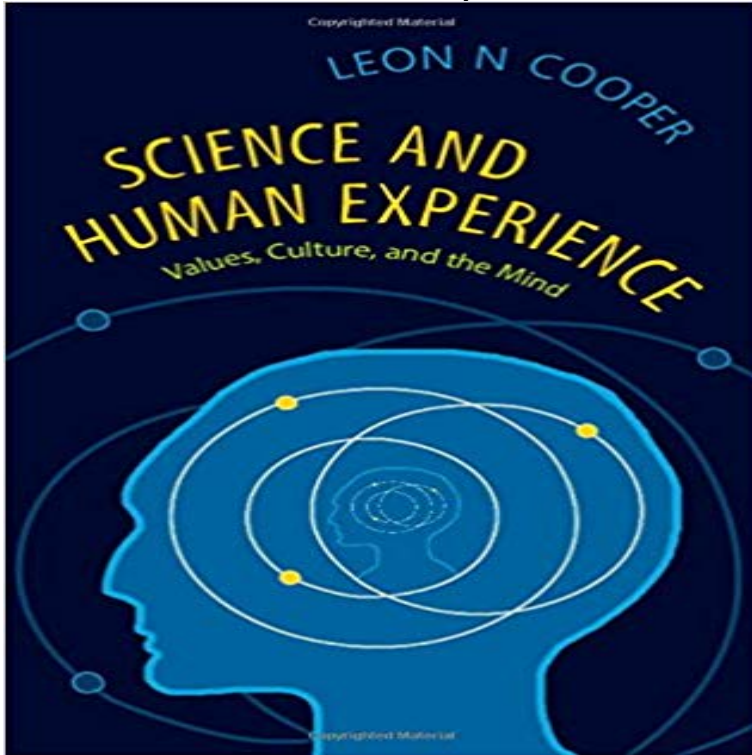


Science and Human Experience: Values, Culture, and the Mind
