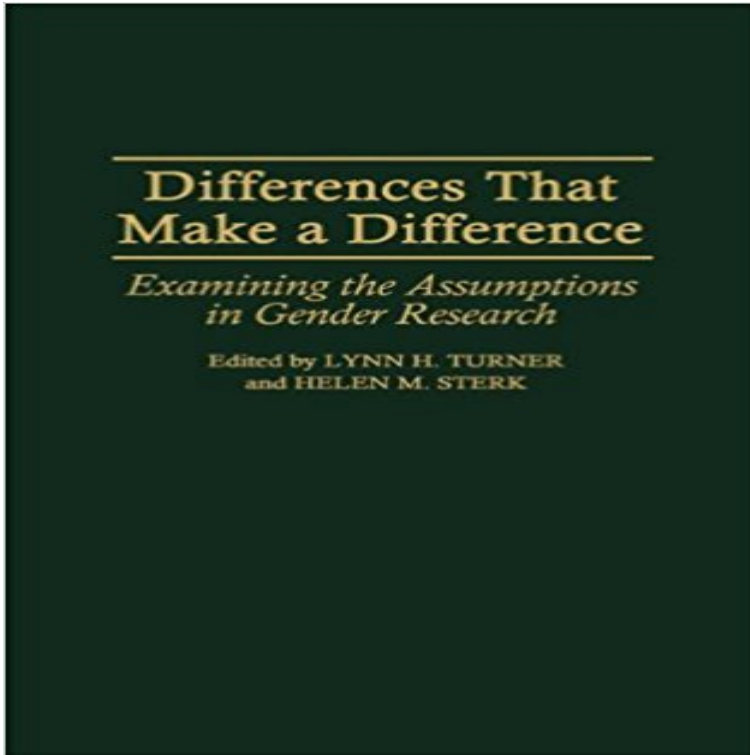


Differences That Make a Difference: Examining the Assumptions in Gender Research
