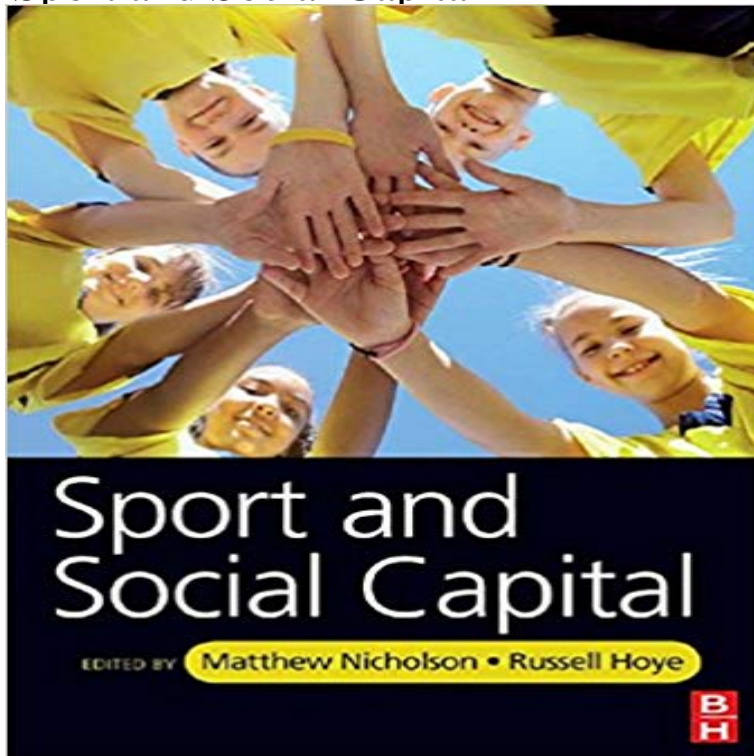


## Sport and Social Capital
